Plant native plants in the school grounds to encourage native wildlife.	All Classes	April 2007
Make plans for a wildlife area in the school garden with log piles, bird feeders and bug boxes.	Primary 5 and 4	March 2007
Monitor the wildlife in the school garden, create a logbook of species seen, and do a mini-beast audit.	Primary 2 and 4	May 2007
Design and plan a layout for the garden space.	Primary 5 and parents	March 2007
