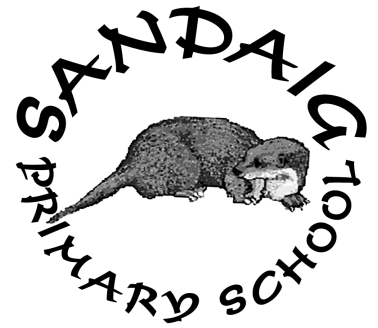

## Sandaig Stride

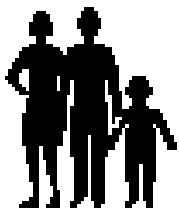

Sandaig children are being challenged to walk the equivalent of around Scotland.
